**GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the June 14, 2017 Order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the California Judicial Council, issued in response to the June 13, 2017 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Alameda County (“Court”), as to the Court’s business in Oakland, California, at the Wiley W. Manuel Courthouse, the René C. Davidson Courthouse, the Alameda County Administration Building, and the United States Post Office Building at 201 Thirteenth Street, this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For purposes of computing time under Penal Code section 825, June 15, 2017 is deemed a holiday (Gov. Code, § 68115(d));

2. Where necessary and appropriate, and with the concurrence of the Presiding Judge, the Court may order that sessions be held anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, on June 15, 2017 (Gov. Code, § 68115(a));

3. In appropriate cases, the Court may extend the time period provided in section 859b of the Penal Code for the holding of a preliminary examination from 10 court days to not more than 11 days in cases in which the examination is set to take place on June 15, 2017 (Gov. Code, § 68115(g)); and


4. In appropriate cases, the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than one day (Gov. Code, § 68115(h)).

This order applies to proceedings in the above-listed Court facilities in which the last day of the statutory time period would occur on July 15, 2017. All judicial officers of this Court are authorized to make case-specific determinations as to whether it is appropriate to (1) extend the time period in any particular case in which condition three or four of this order applies; or

1 (2) order that any particular session be held anywhere in the county, under condition two of this
2 order.

3 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
