

## TREATMENT COURT

---

### *Incentives & Sanctions*

*Responses to behavior are most effective when:*

*They are designed to change future behavior, not punish past actions.*

*They are gradual in intensity.*

*They are consistent.*

*Treatment should not be given as a "sanction."*

<b>INCENTIVES</b>	<b>SANCTIONS</b>
Praise from Judge/Team	Admonishment from Judge/Team
Cases are called by order of phases	Case is heard last
Raffle ticket for targeted behavior	No raffle ticket
Gift card for treatment and testing	No gift card
Decreased contact with Case Manager	Increased contact with Case Manager
Recovery message stone or other token	CBT exercise w/ case manager in the office
Recovery coin or other token	Increased Court appearances
Phase Move	Phase movement frozen/denied
Reduced fines (Amnesty program/Homeless Court)	"Change My Game" recommitment letter
Tell your story in court	All-day jury box
Recommendation for early probation release	Interview all phase four participants, "how'd you do it?"
Challenge Coin	Flash incarceration
Graduation from the program	Discharged from program/returned to referring court
