

COVID-19 HEALTH ASSESSMENT

HEALTH SCREENING QUESTIONS	YES	NO
1. Within the last 24 hours have you been diagnosed with		
COVID-19 or had a test confirming you have the virus?		
2. Have you had any one or more of these symptoms within		
the past 24 hours, which is new or not explained by a reason		
other than possibly having COVID-19?		
- Fever, Chills, or Repeated Shaking/Shivering		
- Cough		
- Sore Throat		
- Shortness of Breath, Difficulty Breathing		
- Feeling Unusually Weak or Fatigued		
- Loss of Taste or Smell		
- Muscle Pain		
- Nausea or Vomiting		
- Diarrhea		

If you answer "yes" to any of the above questions:

- Test as soon as possible to determine infection status.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 and have symptoms, with or without fever, isolate for 24 hours from symptom onset; you may leave isolation after 24 hours if you are feeling well, symptoms are mild and improving, and you have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.
 - o **If you have no symptoms,** there is no infectious period and no recommended isolation period. If symptoms develop, the criteria above will apply.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19, wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days from the start of symptoms or if you did not have COVID-19 symptoms, 10 days from the date of your first positive COVID-19 test. You may remove your mask sooner than 10 days if you have two sequential negative tests at least one day apart.
