PROBATE PACKET - CARE Act Proceedings

This packet contains the Judicial Council forms required to initiate a formal Petition to Commence CARE Act Proceedings. "The Community Assistance, Recovery, and Empowerment" (CARE) Act authorizes specified adult persons to petition a civil court to create a voluntary CARE agreement or a court-ordered CARE plan that can include treatment, housing support, and other services for persons with untreated schizophrenia or other psychotic disorders.

A Petition to Commence CARE Act Proceedings may be filed at the following court locations: Berkeley Courthouse, Hayward Hall of Justice, and the Rene C. Davidson Courthouse.

CARE Act proceedings will be heard on Thursdays in Department 103 at the Oakland- Wiley W. Manuel Courthouse, commencing December 12, 2024.

To begin your Petition to Commence CARE Act Proceedings, please complete the following Judicial Council forms.

It is recommended that you <u>bring 2 additional copies of the completed forms</u> when you file the petition and any subsequent documents in-person, by mail, or drop box with the clerk of the court.

eFiling – If you are self-represented, you may also electronically file (eFile) the petition and any supporting documents. However, If you are represented by an attorney, the petition and subsequent documents must be filed electronically. (See Local Rule 7.2 Electronic filing and service in probate proceedings.)
